The Student Ambassador Program is a leadership opportunity for students who are dedicated to serving and representing Dominica State College. Student Ambassadors provide campus tours, serve as DSC representatives and perform various duties on campus and at community events.

What are the roles/responsibilities of a Student Ambassador?

1. Welcome and greet students from other institutions.
2. Provide various services and referrals to the campus.
3. Develop an expanded knowledge of Dominica State College.
4. Conduct campus tours for new students, schools, classes, and guests.
5. Represent Dominica State College at public events (local and foreign).
6. Assist with duties and tasks related to events hosted and organized by various Dominica State College departments.
7. Work with diverse populations and provide tips on being a successful student.
8. Maintain Student LIFE's service areas appearance and professionalism.
9. Assist the Department of Student Affairs with office related tasks.
10. Must contribute 39 voluntary hours per semester to the college.
11. All other duties as assigned.

As a Student Ambassador you will develop a wide range of transferable skills that will benefit you. Employers, colleges and universities are looking for more than just good grades; they want community involvement and service! Becoming a Student Ambassador

Qualifications

- Must be a currently enrolled Dominica State College student.
- Must be currently enrolled in at least 12 credits.
- Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25.
- Position has a one academic year commitment. (**Semesters 1 & 2**)
- Demonstrate strong communication (written and verbal) and interpersonal skills.
- Exhibit leadership, initiative, dependability, discipline and enthusiasm.
